2008 Rate Schedule

All campsite rates include 2 people and 2 cars. A third car is charged \$10.00 a day. If you need to bring four cars you will need to rent another campsite! Children ages 3 to 17 and Senior Citizens (over age 60) are \$4.00 a night each. Additional adults are \$6.00 a night each. Separate families sharing 1 campsite with separate camping equipment (including tents) will be charged for a campsite (not a visitor's fee). The maximum number of adults that are allowed on a campsite at any time is 4 (this includes overnight visitors). The maximum number of people is 7.

The 4 week rate for Children ages 3 to 17 and Senior Citizens is \$70.00 and for additional adults is \$90.00.

Midweek Discounts

Sunday night thru Thursday night beginning May 27 and ending on June 19, deduct \$3.00 a night.

Sunday night thru Thursday night beginning September 2(except Oct 13) and ending on October 23, deduct \$3.00 a night.

October 30 to April 10 Sunday thru Thursday check in after 4 PM & check out before 9 AM (1 night only) \$15.00.

Spring and Fall Gas Saver

The Gas Saver program is available from April 4 until June 22 and from September 5 to October 31. Camp two nights a week and receive free on site storage the other 5 nights that week. You may camp as many consecutive weekends as you want.

Every 8th night of camping is free. Payment in full is due upon arrival. Gas savers are rented on an as available basis and should be reserved early. Back Lakefront campsites will not be rented as Gas- savers. The on site storage does not include electric if you want to leave your trailer plugged in the charge is \$1.50 a night.

Camping Clubs

Camping clubs are welcome from September thru May. Camping clubs will receive a 10% discount providing that they reserve 10 or more campsites and the wagon master collects. The pavilion and activity center are available at certain times for club activities please check when making your reservation. Discounts do not apply on Holiday weekends; including Halloween.

A \$200.00 deposit is required.

Visitor Policy

A visitor is a person that does not register for the entire length of stay. This includes your children and other family members. It includes those who are dropping something or someone off and also people that just wanting to drop in and say "Hi". Visitors are charged by the day. Overnight visitors are charged for two days. All day visitors must be out by 10 PM. We have the right to limit the number of visitors. Visitors who are here less than an hour & return their car pass will have their money refunded. All visitors must register & pay the fees before entering the campground. Adults are charged \$8.00 each day. Children ages 3 to 17 & Senior Citizens are charged \$5.00 each day. Overnight visitors must pay for 2 days.

RESERVATIONS POLICYS AND PROCEDURES

For phone reservations please call 1-800-345-1369 between 9 AM and 8 PM. (winter hours are limited). Spring and fall reservations are accepted for 2 or more nights with a \$50.00 deposit, except for Memorial Day and Columbus Day weekends they are reserved for 3 nights and require a \$70.00 deposit. **All non-lakefront advance summer reservations (June 25 to September 1) are accepted for a minimum of 5 nights and require a \$100.00 deposit. There is a 7 night minimum for all Lakefront campsites from June 22 to September 1 and require a deposit of \$100.00.** An additional deposit is required for longer reservations. If you want to stay for less than 5 nights; please call a few days prior to your planned arrival date and if we have an available campsite we will reserve one for you.

Deposits can be paid with a visa or master card, cash or if there is sufficient time a check may be sent. The deposit will hold the campsite until 10 PM on your arrival date, unless the reservation is reconfirmed by phone .If we do not have the deposit within 10 days of the date the reservation was made the reservation will be cancelled. Written confirmation is sent when there is enough time. Your deposit is your promise that you will be here on the date you specify for the length of time that you specify, and also, our promise to save a campsite for the dates you specify. Specific campsites can be requested and we will try our best to accommodate your request, but due to unforeseen circumstances we can not positively guarantee specific campsites. All campsite balances are due upon arrival and can be paid by cash, debit, visa or MasterCard only (checks are not accepted at check in). The maximum number of people on one campsite is 7 and out of the 7 people allowed only 4 can be adults and 2 cars.

Cancellations and Date Changes

For a refund of your deposit, to transfer the deposit to another date, or change the arrival or departure date, we must have 15 days notice. Before any money is refunded you must either send in the mail, or fax us at 1-570-223-0124, a note saying that you have cancelled. There is a \$6.00 fee. **If a reservation is cut back and we are able to re rent the site for the original length of stay we will move you to another site.** We do understand that sometimes a reservation must be cancelled because of a circumstance that is beyond your control, unfortunately the campsite was held, and therefore we will not make exceptions to this cancellation policy.

 Please read and understand our reservation and cancellation policy's before making a reservation.

Before you decide to camp with us please keep in mind the following, anyone who does not comply with our rules will be asked to leave.

1. Quiet time is from 11 PM to 8 AM. During these hours all children must be on a campsite and in the company of their parents or another responsible adult. After 11 PM all public areas of the campground are closed and cars may only be used to enter or leave the campground. All noise must be confined to the campsite. If you, your radio or TV can be heard from the next site or the road you are too loud.
2. Bicycles and Roller Blades are permitted. They may be used during daylight hours only. We do not allow skate boards, motorized bikes, or golf carts.
3. All vehicles must be registered, insured and driven by licensed drivers! This includes mopeds. Motorcycles may only be ridden to a campsite and when leaving the campground.
4. Quiet pets are permitted. All pets must be kept on a leash and cleaned up after. Pets may not be left unattended.
5. The size of each site campsite is determined by the size of the "gravel pad" and driveway. All of your camping equipment and vehicles must fit in these areas. You may not use the woods or brush area in between or behind sites for camping equipment or parking.
6. You may not cut down any trees! You may not drive nails into them break off branches or in any way harm a tree. You may bring your own firewood, (or buy it here).
7. We do not allow BB guns or any other type of firearm. We do not allow fireworks.
8. The legal drinking age in Pennsylvania is 21 and will be strictly enforced. Alcoholic beverages are only allowed on campsites. You may not drink any alcohol in any public areas of the campground.

Otter Lake Recreational Facilities and Activities

No license is required for fishing in our well stocked 60 acre spring fed lake. The lake has bass, pickerel, perch as well as sunny's and catfish. Our lake is catch and release only. There are row boats, canoes, Kayaks and pedal boats for rent by the hour, day, or week. You may bring your own boat free of charge, remembering that Pennsylvania State law requires life jackets for each person and a whistle or horn in each boat. Electric motors are permitted on registered boats, but not gasoline.

We have swimming at three locations. Our outdoor pool has grassy lawn for sunning, a diving area with a diving board a slide and a separate enclosed kiddy pool. On the lake there is a sandy beach with a roped off swimming area. The heated indoor pool is open all year, with limited hours in the spring and fall and weekends only from mid October until May. Located at the indoor pool are a sauna and 2 whirlpools. Children are not allowed in the indoor pool at night during July and August.

We have daily planned activities from **June 27 to Labor Day** and on weekends in the spring and fall. In our Activities Center there are children's arts & crafts, ceramics, movies, bingo, and a church service. There are daily fire truck rides. We have live entertainment at our large pavilion on Saturday nights. The Activities Director uses the ball field for daily planned activities. Every week there is archery, soccer or kickball during the day and softball games at night on our lighted field. We also have 4 tennis courts, 2 racquetball courts and a basketball court all with lights for night use. Two shuffleboard courts and horseshoe pits are also available. We have four playgrounds in different areas of the campground. Each has something to climb on ride on or swing from. There is a \$5.00 deposit for shuffleboard horseshoes, basketball and tennis or racquetball racquets. We sell racquetball and tennis balls or you may bring your own.

WINTER CAMPING & YEAR ROUND CAMPING

Winter Season November 1 to April 1

The water is turned off to all sites from November to April 1. Hot and cold water is available at the bath houses. The bath house in the "H" section is closed in the winter.

Winter Season campsites are available for \$850.00 for 4 people plus electric. Additional children are \$40.00 and additional adults are \$60.00.

There are miles of snowmobile trails through the state forest for snowmobiling.

All electric is metered and billed every 2 months. All rates are based on 2 people.

Children are \$125 and additional adults are \$140.00 a year.
